

Diane Zeleny is Director of the Communications Division of Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty. She joined RFE/RL in Prague in September 2007 after more than 18 years with the U.S. State Department, working on transatlantic policy issues, media strategy, outreach, and public diplomacy.

At RFE/RL, Diane Zeleny is responsible for corporate media strategy, government relations and public affairs, overseeing RFE/RL communications programs in Washington D.C. and Prague. She came to Prague from Brussels where she established and led the U.S. government's first regional public diplomacy office. Prior to that Diane Zeleny served as Director of Strategic Communications to U.S. Under Secretary of State for Public Diplomacy and Public Affairs Karen Hughes. Diane also held the position of Director of the U.S. Public Diplomacy Office at NATO headquarters in Brussels. She has lived and worked in Paris, Istanbul, Brussels, and Washington, D.C.

Diane holds a Master's Degree in International Relations from the Centre d'Etudes Diplomatiques et Stratégiques in Paris, and a B.A. in English literature and French language from the University of Iowa.
